Dear Student,

Bradley University applied for and was approved to receive CARES Act - Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds from the federal government. The distribution of these funds is based on the criteria developed by the US Department of Education. **These guidelines recently changed, to your benefit, and you are now eligible to receive CARES Act funds distributed through Bradley.**

You will receive a one-time \$400 grant for incurred expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to COVID-19. You do not need to apply for the \$400 grant funding and a check has been sent to your home address. By cashing the grant check, the student confirms they have incurred \$400 in expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to COVID-19.

Dear Applicant,

Thank you for your patience as we reviewed the applications for the CARES Act funding. The review process was complicated by evolving guidelines issued by the U.S. Department of Education.

The CARES Act Team considered your application for additional funds to cover extraordinary expenses you incurred related to the disruption of campus operations due to Covid-19. The available funds were not sufficient to cover all eligible expenses that students submitted. Also some submitted expenses were not eligible for funding according to Department of Education guidelines. Your award will be sent this week by check to the address you supplied on your application. Please understand that it may not cover all of the expenses that you submitted in your application and it is only intended to offset expenses that have not been previously reimbursed with CARES Act funds disbursed by the University.

Bradley University has awarded CARES Act funding to all eligible students who submitted an application as of May 28, 2020. Approximately 800 students applied for additional funds through the application process. An award amount of \$720 was awarded to all applicants who listed more than \$720 in eligible expenditures on their application. If you requested less than \$720, you will receive the actual amount of your request that was eligible for funding.
