The total amount of funds Bradley University will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Student for ARP – HEERF III is \$5,542,391.

The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed by Bradley University to students under the ARP – HEERF III Act as of September 30, 2021 was \$0.

The estimated total number of students at Bradley University eligible to participate in program in ARP funding distribution is approximately 2,100 students based upon the criteria that Bradley University is considering to prioritize student need.

The total number of Bradley University students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant from Bradley University under ARP – HEERF III as of September 30, 2021 was 0.
