



SUMMER ORIENTATION COVID-19 UPDATE:

All students and guests, regardless of vaccination status, are required to wear masks in indoor public spaces throughout campus, including classrooms. Per the CDC, vaccinated individuals do not need to wear a mask in outdoor settings. If you are unvaccinated, we strongly encourage you to wear your mask in outdoor settings.
